Objectives:

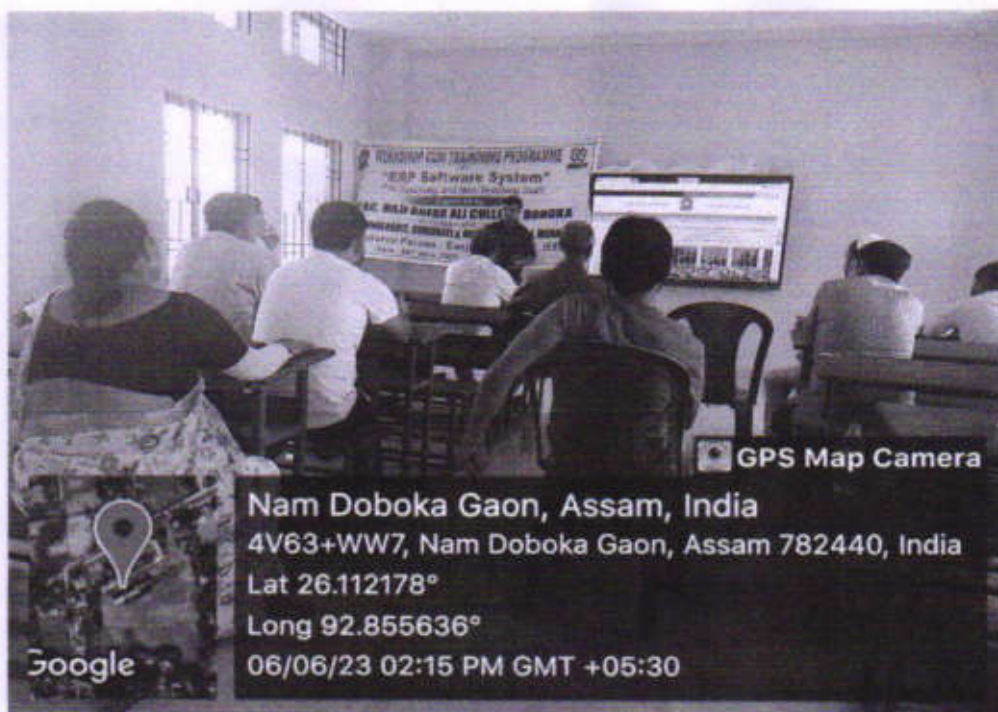
1. To familiarize participants with the concept of ERP software system.

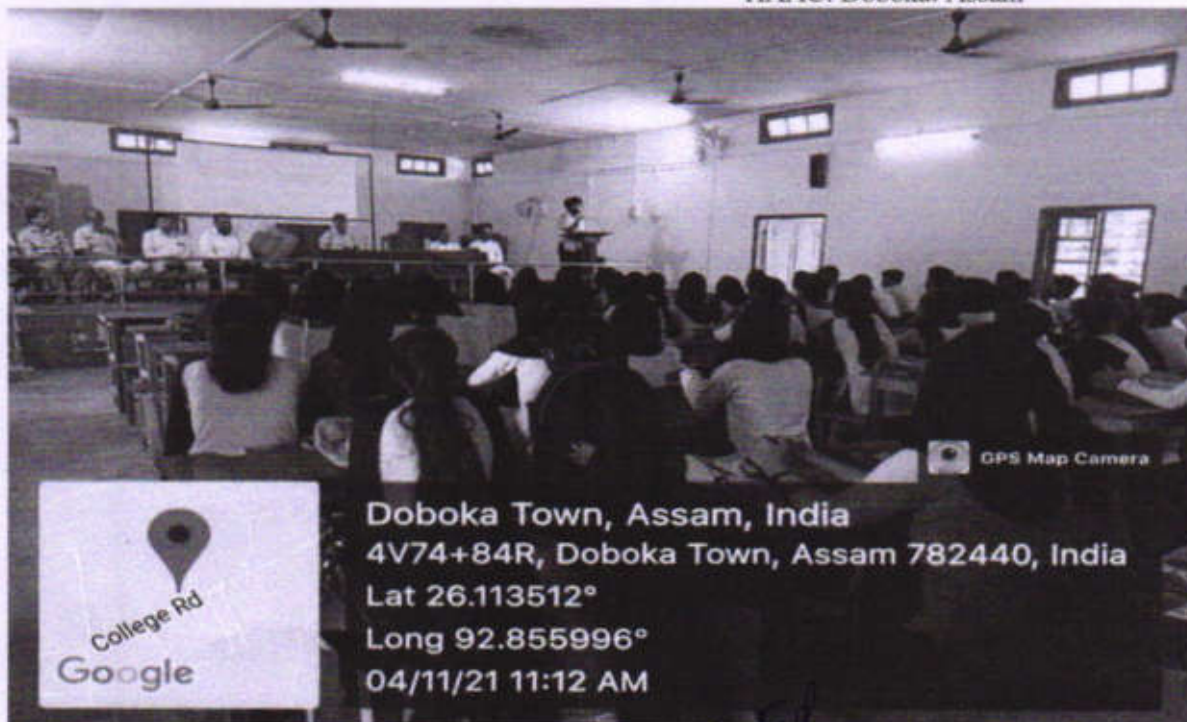

The programme concluded with thanks to all participants by the Principal Dr. Mamun Azam Barbhuyan anticipating more cooperation between two colleges in coming days.

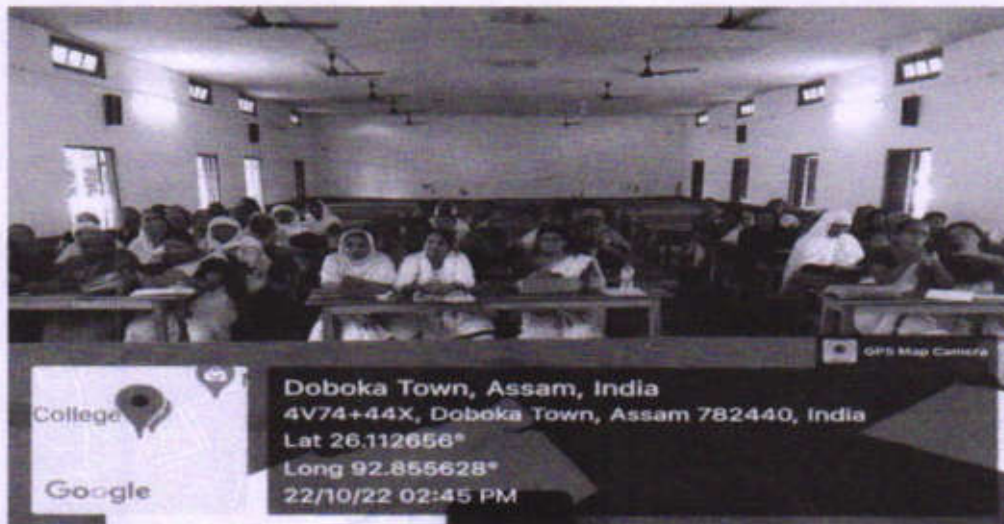

Report: Awareness Programme on Career Opportunities In Legal Studies



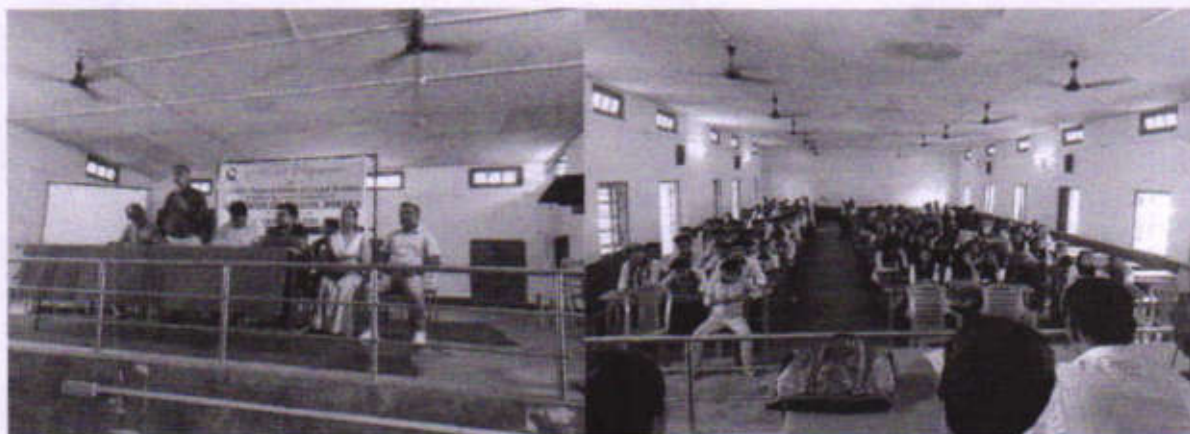

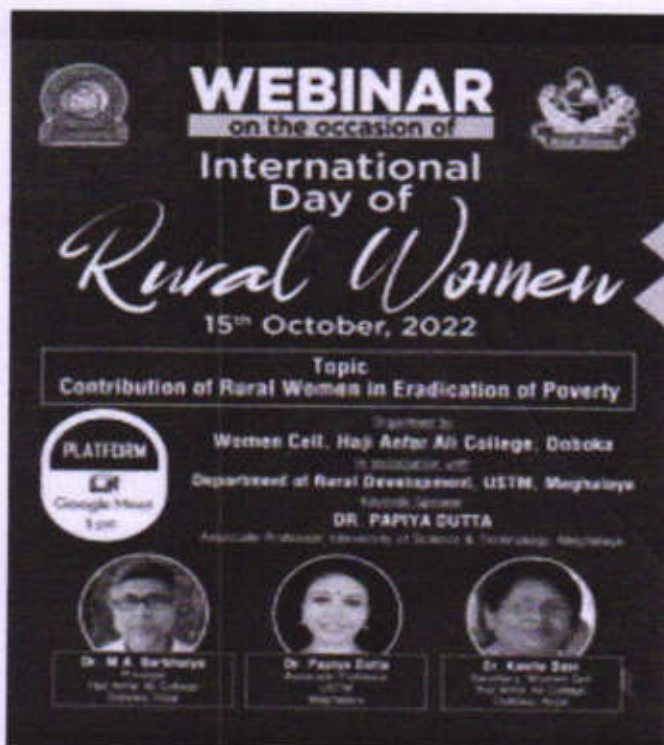
Major outcome:

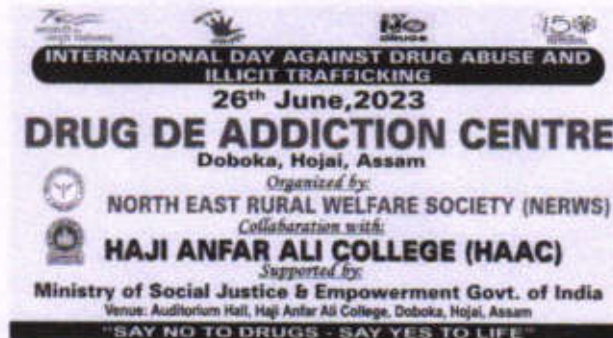

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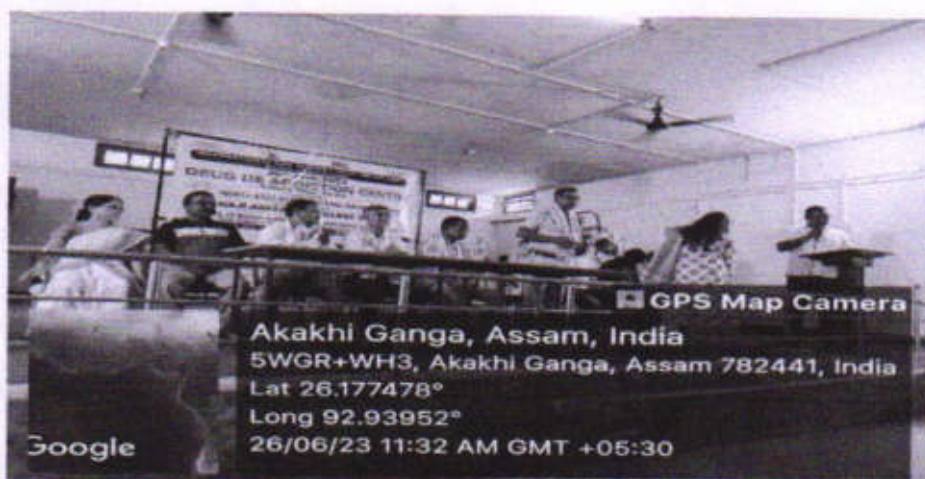
Report of the International Day of Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking

Visit of Principals of Mayang Anchalik College and Jagiroad College: A Collaborative Effort

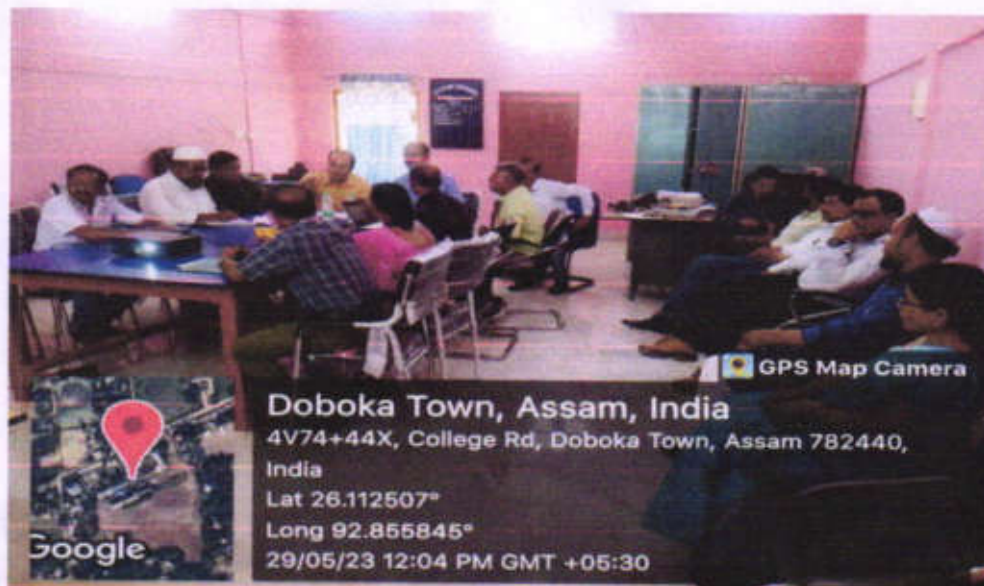
